ORDINANCE NO. 1230

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT §10-426 PROVIDING FOR LICENSING OF FOOD VENDORS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STROMSBURG, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. That §10-426 of the City of Stromsburg Municipal Code shall be adopted as follows to-wit:

MOBILE FOOD VENDORS: LICENSE REQUIRED.

1. It shall be unlawful for any person or person to sell food and food related items from a motor vehicle or from a location not in an enclosed building without first obtaining a permit therefore from the governing body. In order to obtain the permit, the person or business entity engaged in the selling of food and food related items shall submit an application to the City along with current copies of evidence of the following:
 - a. Certificate of Inspection from the Nebraska Department of Agriculture
 - b. Nebraska Department of Revenue Sales Tax Certification
 - c. Evidence of Liability Insurance from a company authorized to do business in the State of Nebraska

The license issued shall be valid for one year from the date of issuance.

The license may be revoked without notice to the licensee in the event that any of the three certificates or evidence of insurance are revoked or canceled or in the event the licensee causes an accumulation of litter or debris to occur in and around the place of sale.

2. No mobile food vendor shall operate their truck or other equipment in a residential district while engaged in the sale of food and food related items.
3. No mobile food vendor shall park or otherwise operate their equipment directly in front of a business during hours in which the business is open to the public.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or portions thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
